498-AMEN recording instructions

Members of Trinity Lutheran record daily devotions from *Christ in our Home*. Anyone who would like to hear this may do so by calling 498-AMEN (2636). We hope that this will be a meaningful ministry to members of Trinity and the Spring Grove community. Spring Grove Communications has offered this service to us free of charge.

Instructions:

- Please record your message sometime between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Read through the scripture and devotion before recording so you are familiar with what you will be reading.
- Read at a pace that will provide a meaningful listening experience for the caller.
- You do not need to listen to each prompt in its entirety. Simply follow the directions as soon as you hear the instructions.
- At the tone, start reading directly into the telephone. Begin each recording session by saying:
 - "Trinity Lutheran Church of Spring Grove is pleased to bring you daily devotions from *Christ in our Home*. **Devotions for** (fill in the day and date) are from (give scripture reference)."
- Then read the entire Bible verse(s) from your Bible, then the printed devotion, and then the prayer. You have 6 minutes to record.
- You may listen to your message to make sure everything is correct.
- Remember, you can always re-record your message if you make a mistake.

Thank you for making our delicious communion bread!

Communion Bread

Sift the following dry ingredients together three times:

2 c. whole wheat flour

1 c. white flour

1-¼ tsp. baking powder

1-¼ tsp. salt

Stir in: 4 tsp. melted butter

Mix the following wet ingredients together until dissolved:

1 c. very hot water (minimum of 180°)

3 Tbsp. honey

3 Tbsp. molasses

Add wet ingredients to dry ingredients and mix well. Dough should be slightly sticky. Do NOT knead.

Make a log and cut into four pieces. Take one of the four pieces and cut it in half (the pastor will use one of these when breaking the bread during the communion service). On a lightly floured surface flatten each piece into a $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick disk. With a knife score the top of each disk with a cross. Lay each on a baking sheet greased with butter. Bake at 350 degrees for 15 minutes then generously baste the top of each disk with melted butter. Return to the oven for 5 minutes. Let disks cool on a cooling rack.

Communion bread (cut of uncut) should be left in the church kitchen by Saturday morning.

You are welcome to make a double batch to cover the month. If you choose to cut the bread before delivering it to church, only cut up one batch. The bread stays fresher if the disks are frozen whole instead of cubed.

<u>Cutting communion bread</u>: Set aside one of the two small disks. Cut the remaining disks into $\frac{1}{2}$ " x $\frac{1}{2}$ " size pieces. If you prefer not to cut the bread, Linda Pierce has volunteered to cut it.


Thank you for being a Fellowship Hostl

Fellowship Host Instructions and Tips:

- Make coffee
 - instructions are on the wall by the coffee pots, it takes a little time, so plan to start it before worship
 - about 30 cups decaf, 40 cups regular; coffee is on the counter to the right of the refrigerator
 - feel free to bring your own creamer
- Other beverages water is usually served, pitchers can be filled from the tall fauscet and placed in the refrigerator to chill. You can choose to serve other beverages (lemonade, juice, or anything else you'd like). You can personalize it however you'd like!
- Provide treats for 50-70
 Treats can be anything you'd like to provide, savory or sweet...bars, cookies, fruit, breads, muffins, ice cream, store-bought is fine too! This is YOUR day, do what works best for your group!
- Decide how many dishes you'd like to wash serve on paper plates and/or napkins or on the plates found on the carts in the kitchen. There are serving trays in the cupboards that you can use; look for labels on cupboard doors to find where things are located.
- Take a little time to sit down and enjoy a treat and conversation with friends and neighbors before you finish up your fellowship duties. You are doing God's work and you are SO appreciated!
- Clean up when fellowship is over wash and put away mugs, glasses, plates, and silverware that was used. Wipe
 down tables in Fellowship Hall, wipe down kitchen counters, and turn off lights on your way out. Please take any
 extra food/drink items with you.
- Please let us know if you have any questions. We're always striving to make this an easy, enjoyable experience for everyone. If you'd like to add anyone to your group, please do!
