May 8, 2019

The Trinity Lutheran Congregation Council meeting was called to order by Mary Deters at 7:45 pm on May 8, 2019 in the Gathering Room at Trinity Lutheran Church.

Pr Elizabeth opened the meeting with prayer.

Secretary's Report for April 14, 2019 was approved.

Treasurer's Report (placed on file)

- Total income as of the end of April: approximately \$115k; total expenses: approximately \$125k. All bills were paid in April, past due bills. Also, \$5k of the \$10k borrowed has been paid back.
- Thrivent Choice Dollars received: \$4709.00
- For bookkeeping, Lorilyn is requesting a report from all who served a Lenten Supper.

STAFF REPORTS:

Pastor Elizabeth (full report placed on file)

- Attended a First Call Theological Education retreat, April 29-May 1, on the topic "Resilience in Ministry".
- Assisting with worship services at the Festival of Homiletics preaching conference, May 13-17.
- The "community space" idea is moving forward with a presentation to a donor tentatively scheduled for Friday of Syttende Mai weekend.
- The second "farmer roundtable" event will be at Trinity on May 29th from 10-11:30 am.
- The list of candidates for bishop has been narrowed to seven. Representing Trinity as voting members at the Synod Assembly (May31-June1): Sheri Allen, Fred Arnold, Mary Zaffke, and Pr Elizabeth. Bekah and Willy Leafblad will be attending as visitors.
- Parsonage improvements are being made: fencing has been ordered, a patio door is being installed, and most of the rocks are gone.

- The theme for Day Camp, June 24-27th, will be Rolling River Rampage.
- Bekah reported the results of her survey of Release Time parents: 17 of 62 survey responses were received; 80 kids were involved in Release Time for the 2018-2019 school year. Parents commented that:
 - 1. their children like, or even loved Release Time.
 - 2. most wanted Release Time to be for K-6 grades and wanted it to meet once a week or every other week For next year, the current model will continue and some new ideas for curriculum will be tried.

Mission in the World (Steve N)

Staffing

- Lorilyn is presenting a digital timecard to the Staff on May 8th.
- Pr Elizabeth and Jan Kraabel are working on a draft of PTO language to bring to the Staffing Committee.

Worship (Willy)

- The Worship Team is discussing the optimal schedule for Easter services next year, possibly adding another service.
- When learning a new liturgy in the future, they are discussing options for projecting liturgy and/or including it in the bulletin. A new liturgy choice for the future: Behold I Make All Things New
- May offer Communion training in the Fall.
- An outdoor worship service will be held on June 30th.
- Hymn Sing starts on June 9th.
- May find a more permanent location for the cross (used during Easter).

CONTINUING BUSINESS:

Update on the Furnace/Air Conditioner Project (Finance)

 All bills have been paid through March for the Furnace/Air Conditioner project. The work has not been completed, and there will be more installation bills. We have raised \$225,000! An additional \$25,000 would cover the projected balance needed.

<u>Update on Custodian Position</u> (Support/Staffing)

• References have been checked for the one applicant for the custodial position and an email has been sent to set up an interview time.

<u>Update on Hiawatha Valley Education/WIN Program</u>

• Another walk through of Trinity Center will be done on May 14th with a building contractor. They identified some areas of improvements to the physical space they would want/need to make if they buy the property, rather than lease it.

<u>Finance Team Continuing Resolution</u> (Support/Finance)

Congregation Council requested clarification from the Support and Finance Teams on the first goal of the
Continuing Resolution change: Maintain a church environment that members and others will wish to be a part
of. They were asked to report back to the Congregation Council in June.

<u>Summary of Visioning & Planning Team</u> (Steve K, Bev N, Nolie K)

The Visioning & Planning Team was tasked with gathering information in order to make recommendations about the future growth and enhancement of the congregation. Based on the 112 surveys from interviews, forums, and electronic communication, "the ministries of Trinity can be maintained and have the potential to grow with some changes to our existing space."

Results were summarized into three areas:

- Additional, enhanced space: education, welcome/fellowship, accessibility
- Space: storage, updates, flexible, green
- Things that should be retained

A list of "dreams" shared by participants for Trinity's ministries was also compiled. If a decision is made to go forward, the Visioning & Planning Team members asked to talk to the Building Team.

The Congregation Council agreed (with Jacque) that we have assessed the needs and we have a need. Mary reviewed the next step:

 The Congregation Council selects a Building Team Chairperson; a Congregational meeting is scheduled to share the findings and recommendations.
