SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

On Sunday, January 7, immediately following worship, the Council has called a Special Congregational Meeting for the sole purpose of seeking approval to list the second parsonage for sale. The meeting will be held in the sanctuary.

An appraisal was completed on the second parsonage (located at 135 2nd Avenue NE) in August. The value of the home from the appraisal is \$104,000. The Property Team has recommended the sale of this property as Trinity will have only one pastor. There are no outstanding loans on the property.

The 2,655 square foot home sits on a large lot with mature trees. It has four bedrooms, 1-3/4 bathrooms, a large 2-car newer garage, hardwood floors and carpeting. It is newly painted. A dishwasher, refrigerator, and range are included.
