Master Planning update. Kodet/ Terry Nagel/ Kraus Anderson Construction visited the church, met with David Overland and Jerald and Gary Wilhelmson. They shared that the pillars in the fellowship hall were placed on wet clay. This is an item to be figured out for its potential consequences. Measurements were verified. Will be presenting tomorrow night at 5:30

Last Wednesday, there were 4-45 minute sessions. Teams were invited. 21 different people attended to listen. Talking about what we have, how to use it and what we want, in our buildings for the mission of the church.

Trinity Center / Release Time Update

- The Trinity Center/ Release Time Committee will present to the council on Sept. 13.
- Jerald updated on the building. Needed a new water heater, \$200 installed. New part on the boiler. Bruce Bergsgaard is completing a small wiring job. Gary is busy painting. There is a new floor and handicap partitions in the bathroom. Thank you also to Scott and Lee.
- Discussion regarding heating the upstairs. Because of the way that the boiler works, this is not possible. Best to turn the heat to 45-50 degrees. The one room currently being used upstairs, one day a week, could have a programmable thermostat.
- Noted that it is difficult to determine the cost for utilities for the TC. We are committed to using it this fall but need to plan/ budget accordingly.
- Noted at this point also, that Jason Kozee had sent samples for the steeple project. Jerald motioned to approve the color European Gray, Seconded, Jacque. Discussion. Motion failed. Tabled until actual samples could be seen, at next council meeting. Approximate start date for the steeple is mid-September.

- Bethany made a motion, Joyce seconded it, to Finish out the calendar year with the Spring Grove Public Schools and will reevaluate our need for the space at the end of the year. The school may choose to move out before this date of Dec 31, 2023, and we would reimburse them. Motion passed.
- Pastor Elizabeth will talk to the school.
