For there is no distinction, since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God; they are now justified by God's grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God put forward as a sacrifice of atonement by his blood, effective through faith.

Romans 3:22b-25a

Dear friends in Christ,

This passage from Paul's letter to the Romans is traditionally read on Reformation Sunday, along with Psalm 46. It is because of reading and studying this text that Martin Luther formulated the doctrine we in the Lutheran Church call "justification by grace through faith." Let's break it down.

**Justification.** The action of being made right in the sight of God (because we can't do it on our own).

**Grace.** The gift of healing from sin because of the actions of Jesus on the cross (because we can't receive it on our own).

**Faith.** Belief that this is possible (which we have with the help of the Holy Spirit).

On Reformation Sunday, eight young people affirmed their baptism at Trinity. During their years in confirmation classes, they learned many things (I hope). But what they learned most of all (I hope) is that the only thing they really *need* to know is the first part of Luther's explanation to the Third Article of the Apostle's Creed:

"I believe that I cannot by my own understanding or effort believe in Jesus Christ my Lord, or come to him. But the Holy Spirit has called me through the Gospel, enlightened me with his gifts, and sanctified and kept me in true faith."

This is most certainly true. It is true for our new confirmands. It is true for you.

#### **OCTOBER 9, 2019 CONGREGATION COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS**

#### Motions approved:

- To approve adding Directors and Officers insurance to our current insurance policy.
- To allow the use of Trinity's Federal Tax ID# by the Syttende Mai Norwegian Food Stand, as required by the bank.
- To approve Judy Tollefsrud, Barb Arnold, and Jessi Strinmoen to serve on the Nominating Committee.
- To continue with the Silver Plan C benefit package for another year and continue with the \$1,200 per year in additional HAS coverage.
- To give six weeks of paid time off for maternity leave to fulltime employees, not including vacation/PTO time.

#### Updates:

- Karr Tuckpointing Company of Vinton, IA has begun the tuckpointing project. They are finding some issues with the soft brick, so it is taking more time (in addition to the weather delays).
- The Facilities Planning Team will have a third interview with CRW from Rochester on October 30.
- Accepted the Council's decision to charge rent to Beary Patch Preschool for the use of Trinity Center (for cleaning and utilities).
- Clarification was given to the Ad hoc Committee for their task: to discuss the pros and cons of keeping or selling Trinity Center.
- Mission in the World will again coordinate the Alternative Giving Opportunity, offered between Thanksgiving and Christmas.

**BEING GOOD STEWARDS OF THE EARTH** Trinity is switching communion cups to "Thee Friendliest Cups on the Planet." These communion cups will look the same but are made of PLA (polylactide) biopolymer derived from corn (grown right here in the Midwest!) and are 100% renewable, 100% compostable, and 100% biodegradable. In a commercial composting facility, degradation can occur in as little as 90 days. In regular trash, these cups should breakdown in 6-24 months as opposed to conventional polystyrene plastic that takes hundreds of years to degrade.
